

Accessibility Guide for The Guildhall Museum

The Guildhall Museum is located on Rochester High Street, close to Rochester Bridge. Built as a municipal building it has only housed the collection associated with the museum for about forty years.

As a grade one listed building physical access is restricted. However, the collection held at the museum is fully accessible online via the Medway Council webpages.

Level Access

- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - The Introductory Gallery
 - The Shop

Hearing

- We have a hearing loop at the front desk

- Large print interpretation booklets available.

Travel by public transport

- Rochester train station is 0.2 miles from The Guildhall Museum
- The nearest bus stop is on Corporation Street just outside The Guildhall Museum

Parking

- At weekends the High Street is pedestrianised and therefore drop off is only possible during the week.
- There is no parking at the museum, however there is a Medway Council run car park called Cathedral Garage, which is a short distance from The Guildhall Museum.
